

Diana Roberts, the Director of the Office of Catholic Schools for the Diocese of La Crosse has announced her resignation. Her last day will be September 12th. Roberts will be moving to St. Cloud, Minnesota to be near her future husband.

Roberts was hired as the assistant director in 1999 and became the director in 2001. As the director she was responsible for the operation of seven unified school systems, with seven high schools and 31 elementary schools; along with 30 independent schools throughout the diocese.

During her tenure, Aquinas High School, along with 5 others, were named Blue Ribbon Schools, meaning they were either academically superior or have demonstrated gains in student achievements. In 2008, Aquinas High School along with 2 others, were selected for the National Catholic High School Honor Roll that annually recognizes the 50 best Catholic secondary schools in the United States.
