

If the Government Accountability Board schedules recall elections against the Governor, Lt. Governor and Republican Senators on May 29th, as reported last week, would anyone be around to vote? It is the day after Memorial Day. We posed that question to UW-L Political Scientist, Joe Heim.

Heim says he was surprised the GAB would schedule recall elections that early. He says he feels the elections would come about in July....and possibly August when the senate primaries are held. The 2012 United States Senate election in Wisconsin will take place on November 6 alongside a U.S. presidential election as well as other elections to the United States Senate and House of Representatives and various state and local elections.
