

When it comes to property value in the city of La Crosse, it's Gundersen Lutheran and everybody else.

Our look at the top property taxpayers in La Crosse show Gundersen is, by far, the biggest property taxpayer in the city. With property valued at just under 130 million, the medical center pays about three and half million dollars in property tax. That's about double what the owners of the Valley View Mall pay. More than six times what is paid by La Crosse's other big medical center, Franciscan Skemp which has the sixth biggest property tax bill in the city.
