

The Skipperliner situation turns up in court today...

A hearing is scheduled this afternoon in La Crosse on Skipperliner's decision to shut down and seek bankruptcy protection. And the Campbell Town Board appears content to let the courts handle the matter, for now. Town administrator Travis Parish says the board took no action on Tuesday night to seek money from the boat company...even after town residents asked the board to try to get a 600-thousand dollar loan back from Skipperliner. Parish says the board will keep an eye on what the courts decide about the company's responsibility to creditors.
