

Driver Killed In Collision With County Squad Car

ONE PERSON IS DEAD IN A COLLISION BETWEEN A SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT SQUAD CAR AND ANOTHER CAR ON HIGHWAY 35.

THE CRASH HAPPENED AROUND 1 O'CLOCK SUNDAY MORNING, AT THE INTERSECTION OF 35 AND HIGHWAY O-T, NORTH OF ONALASKA. THE SHERIFF'S SQUAD WAS CALLED TO HOLMEN TO PROVIDE BACKUP, WHEN VILLAGE POLICE WENT TO BREAK UP A BAR FIGHT. THE SECOND CAR PULLED ONTO 35 FROM O-T, EVEN THOUGH THE PATROL CAR HAD ITS LIGHTS AND SIREN GOING. THE SECOND DRIVER WAS THROWN FROM THE CAR, AND DIED AT GUNDERSEN LUTHERAN. STATE TROOPERS ARE TRYING TO RECONSTRUCT THE ACCIDENT.
