

No bells and whistles in this state health insurance program. Wisconsin's Badger Care Plus Basic program. \$130 a month. A limited number of doctor visits. Generic drugs only. A new report says the three month old Plus Basic plan is in good shape; covering those 35 hundred on small premiums without tax dollars and still remaining financially sound.
