

Two decades ago, Yousef Gilali raped a woman at knife point behind a dumpster in La Crosse. Now Gilali's been released from prison and is back in La Crosse. Cops say the 42 year-old native Moroccan will live at Attic correctional on Rose street on the city's northside. He's not supposed to be within two blocks of places like playgrounds and parks. Could be a problem, since Attic is across the street from a city park and a private school. Gilali was convicted for a 1991 rape in which he grabbed a woman from behind, put a knife to her neck, covered her mouth, raped her forcibly behind a dumpster and threatened to kill her if she told anyone.
