

One more spot in the state assembly just opened up. Democrat Mark Radcliffe says that he's leaving. The Black River Falls lawmaker says four years is enough, and he won't run for re election this fall.

As part of the state's redistricting plan, Republicans placed Radcliffe in the same district as his fellow Assembly Democrat Chris Danou of Trempealeau.
