

New garbage rules for La Crosse might not fix the city's curbside trash problem. Livable Neighborhoods president Charlie Weeth is among those who question whether the just-approved regulations will achieve promised results. He suggests the benefits of mandates for more dumpsters at rentals might have been oversold a bit.

Weeth says if the volume of garbage is too big for a dumpster then there will still be messes. As there will be if scavengers continue to dumpster-dive and people use the dumpsters illegally.
