

Many energy companies have complained about the burdens of meeting renewable energy standards in Wisconsin. By 2015, all utilities in the state are mandated to meet a ten percent level of energy generation or investment in renewable sources. La Crosse's Dairyland Power has already hit that mark. And then some. A new evaluation of the Co-op's portfolio finds that Dairyland is at 12 percent renewable currently.
