



A Minnesota man charged with killing two La Crosse men, did not fight

extradition back to Wisconsin to face the charges. 39 year old Jeffery Lebsch was in a Winona County Courtroom this morning and sat with his newly appointed public defender during the extradition hearing.

The judge made way for Winona County Sheriff's Deputies to transfer Lebsch to the La Crosse County jail....when that will be in unknown at this time.
