

Four Democratic state lawmakers from Milwaukee this week proposed a series of bills for the upcoming legislative session that would ban assault rifles, outlaw certain ammunition such as the kind used in the Connecticut school shooting, require gun owners with concealed carry permits to receive a clean bill of health after a psychological evaluation and close the so called gun show loophole.
