FORMER LA CROSSE BANKER DONALD JOHNSON IS GOING TO PRISON FOR STEALING NEARLY A MILLION DOLLARS FROM THE RETIREMENT ACCOUNTS OF DOZENS OF PEOPLE. JOHNSON SAID IN COURT HE HAD 'REMORSE' AND 'REGRET,' AND WILL COMPLY WITH THE COURT ORDER TO REPAY CLOSE TO 200-THOUSAND DOLLARS OF WHAT HE HAD TAKEN. JOHNSON LEFT HIS FAMILY IN 1995 AND DISAPPEARED FOR 14 YEARS BEFORE TURNING HIMSELF IN.
