



A Wisconsin teen is the winner of Doodle 4 Google's national contest with her art called "Coming Home."

Google says millions of votes were cast on 130,000 submissions in its annual contest to design the logo on Google's home page.

Sabrina Brady is a senior at Sparta High School. Brady says she created the art in honor of the day her Dad returned home from Iraq after 18 months of military service. It's featured on the Google homepage Thursday. It shows a girl, in black and white, moving toward a soldier with an American flag in her hand. The last letter in the Google logo is a colorful image of the girl hugging the soldier.

Brady wins a \$30,000 college scholarship, a Chromebook computer and a \$50,000 technology grant for her school.
