

On Monday the Minnesota Legislature adjourned after completing its work on the state's budget for Fiscal Years 2014 and 2015. The budget plan, passed largely with support from House and Senate Democrats, was not favorable to State Senator Jeremy Miller who voted in opposition to the budget plan.
