Friday, September 13 7:10 p.m. vs. Reds
Thursday, September 19 1:10 p.m. vs. Cubs
Sunday, September 22 1:10 p.m. vs. Cardinals

Terrace box seats, which normally are \$24 each, are available for \$17 under this program. Likewise, field outfield box seats which are normally \$42 each, will be sold for \$26.
