

A hearing planned for today could provide the last chance for lawyers to offer motions before a double homicide trial begins in La Crosse.

Jeff Lepsch is scheduled to be tried two weeks from now for a double murder at May's Photo in downtown La Crosse. Store owner Paul Petras and his son A-J were shot inside the store last fall, during an apparent robbery. At a hearing in May, Lepsch's attorneys asked to have the murder charges dismissed, because police may have erased security video from the crime scene by accident. The motion was withdrawn later.
