

A community service inmate program in Monroe County has been broken. That's what Justice Department Coordinator, Peggy Thorson says is what happened after it's former director was sentenced to jail Wednesday for sexually assaulting two inmates working in the program. Thorson apologized to the court before Adam Helgerson was sentenced.
