

Two-Time La Crosse Bank Robber Sentenced to 25

It's 25 years in prison for a Watertown man who confessed to robbing two banks in La Crosse. Jeffrey Haydock was sentenced today for the robberies of Citizens State Bank in June and Firefighters Credit Union in May. Haydock was arrested at his home in Watertown shortly after the second robbery and apparently confessed a short time later to both heists. Along with the 25 years behind bars, the 53 year-old will have 10 years of extended supervision and will have to pay thousands of dollars in restitution.
