Greg Davids could be home from the hospital within a week, after having heart bypass surgery yesterday in Rochester.

The Republican lawmaker from Preston had a quadruple bypass following a doctor's exam on Monday, according to legislative assistant Kitty Musty. She says Davids did NOT have a heart attack, and no heart damage was found by doctors. Davids may have to spend about five days in the hospital. He's running for re-election to the House this year, but was NOT on the primary ballot yesterday.
