



The Onalaska Board of Education will put a three part referendum up for a

vote to city residents today. The primary ballot includes questions on a \$16 million addition to Northern Hills Elementary School. An approval to exceed the revenue limit by \$1.9 million over two years and an added \$500 thousand for technology upgrades over five years are also included in the referendum.
