



Back in 1993, 51 year old Steven Warner of Sparta was tried and convicted of sexually assaulting a 5 year old girl. He spent 20 years in prison and was released in May of last year. Another 5 year old girl was assaulted at the same time....and after she came forward...Warner was been charged again.
