

Teen Driver Charged In Crash That Killed 3

Six months after a car crash killed three teenage girls in Winona County, a 17-year-old boy is being charged with causing their deaths.

Since the crash last April near Lewiston, there has been speculation that a second car somehow was involved in the accident. The county attorney's office now says there's evidence that two cars were racing before one of them rolled over. Now, Adam Greden is suspected of driving the other car which did not crash. The charges are filed in Winona County juvenile court, but the prosecutor will attempt to have Greden tried as an adult. A fourth girl was hurt seriously in the rollover.
