

What do we have here.....

Friday night police raids on the home and business of a candidate for the St. Charles City Council turned up over \$85 thousand worth of high grade marijuana, cash and firearms.

Winona County Sheriff Dave Brand said officers executing search warrants on 52 year old Stephen Conlin of St. Charles discovered seven marijuana plants in a grow-room in Conlin's home, 61 plants drying in a utility shed and 17 1/2 pounds of processed marijuana. Additional marijuana plants were seized from his business in St. Charles. Police also grabbed a half a dozen guns and over \$1000 in cash.

Conlin will be on the ballot November 2nd.

The case has been referred to the Winona County Attorney.
