

Man Charged With Beating Cop

A Norwalk man, charged with attempted homicide of a Monroe County Sheriff's Deputy, will make his next court appearance in Monroe County on Tuesday. 23-year-old Rodrigo Medina-Ferrer is also charged with escaping from custody and armed burglary for the incident in which he was arrested before his alleged escape.

Seems as though Medina-Ferrer broke into a woman's house and tried punching her father with a metal belt buckle. When he was arrested for that, Medina-Ferrer managed to open the window of squad car, wiggle out, cut a chain on his hand-cuffs, charge at a deputy, and strike him repeatedly in the head with the cuffs.
