

The Government Accountability Board says they figure they will need over \$650 thousand to get upcoming recall elections set up. But the GAB's Reid Magney, says that won't be it money wise.

The GAB has not officially asked for the money but it did break down the expected costs for the Legislature's Joint Finance Committee, which would allocate the funding. The board said it would need 50 temporary workers, and office space for them to check the validity of up to one and a half million petition signatures.
