

Divers Find Body In Wisconsin River

Stevens Point Search and Rescue teams have pulled a body from the Wisconsin River. But the body has not been identified. Search crews spent the morning looking for Eric Duffey, a UW Stevens Point student who hasn't been seen since early Saturday morning. Police say they were searching the Wisconsin River for a missing college student who may have accidentally walked into the water. Assistant Chief Brian Kudronowich said firefighters were on boats today searching for 21-year-old Eric Duffey. The University of Wisconsin-Stevens Point student disappeared early Saturday morning after celebrating his 21st birthday. Since then, police and volunteers were scouring neighborhoods near downtown Stevens Point where Duffey was last seen. Kudronowicz says Duffey may have walked into the river. He says alcohol could be a factor.
