The coach, Brady Olson, is also a school science teacher, and was using the dry ice to entertain the basketball team back in January...according to a criminal complaint in Trempealeau County Court. Olson is being charged with felony child abuse for the dry-ice incident. The G-E-T superintendent says Olson has been disciplined, but won't say how.
