The La Crosse city council will have two appointed representatives before long. Applications are now being accepted to fill the seat resigned by Jim Bloedorn this week. Bloedorn could no longer hold the seat after moving out of the seventh district. The successful applicant will serve out the remainder of Bloedorn's term until April. In May, college freshman Karen Svitovsky was appointed to the fifth district seat on the council to take the seat resigned by Eric Schmidt. Her term also expires next April. Applications for the seventh district seat will be accepted until the 23rd of this month.
