When a husband and wife were found shot to death at their Nodine home this winter, it was thought to be a murder-suicide.

Now, an investigation confirms that Morgan Nederhiser shot wife Debrah three times in the head before killing himself. The Winona County Attorney also rules that Mr. Nederhiser killed the couple's greyhound dogs before he shot himself. A suicide note was e-mailed to another person that day. The official report from Winona County does not determine a motive, but reports at the time of the shooting suggested that Morgan Nederhiser was having problems with his business.
