The Tomah couple that were found dead in their home Monday did not die by blunt force trauma of any kind. That's the latest from Police Chief, Wes Revels. He says autopsy's confirmed that neither Michael Bobeck or Tracey Small died of gunshot wounds, trauma or anything that would indicate a violent death. We asked Revels if they know what the pair died of.

He says they will have to wait for toxicology reports, which could take several weeks. The pair were found in their eastside Tomah home Monday morning.
