

La Crosse Shooting Update

La Crosse Police are looking for two individuals that they say were involved with a shooting that took place Sunday. Police were sent to the area of 5th and Winnebago for a report of gun fire and an argument. While enroute additional information was received that there was a female who had sustained a gunshot wound. Officers spoke with the 24 year old female victim inside her vehicle at 5th and Market St. It was discovered that she had sustained a non-life threatening gunshot wound to the lower back. She was immediately transported to Gundersen Hospital where she underwent surgery and is in stable condition.

As part of the investigation La Crosse Police interviewed the victim as well as several other individuals that were present at the time of the incident. Police say there were approximately 15 people present at the time of the shooting however very little reliable information was obtained through police interviews. Police are in the process of obtaining and reviewing video from local businesses as part of the investigation.

Police have identified two people of interest that they would like to speak with: 21 year old Cordero Short with a last known address out of Chicago and 24 year old Terrell Adams out of Illinois.

Due to the lack of consistent and credible information, the La Crosse Police is looking for help from the public.
