

Aurora Sinai Medical Center in Milwaukee has confirmed it has isolated a patient infected with a deadly superbug bacteria that they say did not originate in the hospital. They say the bacteria typically originates outside the country. Gunderson Health System's Bridget Pfaff says it's not the first case of the deadly super bug in the Badger State.
