

Bluff Park and Road Both Move Forward in Front of Council

The La Crosse city council has its eyes turned towards the bluff this week. The council has approved the creation of a committee to sit down with surrounding towns and hash out some kind of agreement about repairing Bliss Road. The road to Granddad Bluff has been washed out for weeks. The council has also agreed to accept a DNR grant to help fund a spendy reconstruction of the park at the top of the bluff. The timing of the decisions leading to the possibility that Granddad Bluff Park might be done right about the same time the only city road to the park is back in service.
